2. ESCC Indemnity Form

I, the undersigned, being the parent/guardian of _____

1. Hereby indemnify, hold harmless and absolve the Head, employees, leaders or members (hereafter referred to as "The Leadership") chaperoning the students of the aforesaid Church, acting in good faith as agents of the Eldership of El Shaddai Christian Church, Durbanville, Cape Town, against all claims whatsoever as may arise from accident or injury to, or any loss or damage to the property of, the above named student, which may occur whilst on the ESCC Youth Summer Camp during 8 December 2016 to 11 December 2016, or arising there from or in consequence thereof.
2. The Leadership will appoint and delegate its powers given to them by virtue of this Agreement to responsible chaperones known to them who will act in *loco parentis* and at all times will exercise such behaviour towards the above named student and exercise such control as is consistent with that of a reasonable parent.
3. The El Shaddai Christian Church, the Head of the aforesaid church, any members of the aforesaid church and employees of the aforesaid church will under no circumstance accept liability for any losses, damages and/or injuries sustained by any person forming part of the church's youth group, which includes any and all activities and outings by the youth group, and/or any losses, damages or injury which may arise from negligence and/or any conduct and/or failure to act by the aforesaid church, the head of the aforesaid church, any members of the aforesaid church, and/or employers thereof.
4. No responsibility by the Leadership acting as agents can be taken for injury and accident which occurs as a result of a breach of Church guidelines, rules and regulations as and where perpetrated by the above named student.
5. I the undersigned, agree that in the event of the above named student requiring emergency medical attention which may or may not involve the administration of an anaesthetic and an operation by a suitably qualified medical practitioner/specialist, and in which instance the parents cannot be reached, due permission and authorisation may, in such instances, be given by the Leadership or any other member of the staff authorised so to do. Such a decision will be made on the clear understanding that the person providing the necessary consent is acting in *loco parentis* and acting as a responsible parent in giving the approval.
6. Notwithstanding the above provisions, approval of this Notification of Indemnity does not in any way remove or deny student or parent(s)/guardian(s) those safeguards which are afforded according to the laws of South Africa, under whose jurisdiction, to the exclusion of all others, this Indemnity pertains.

From the N1 (near Ratanga Junction):

1. Head southwest on N1 toward Exit 7B	5,9 km
2. Take exit 3 for Lower Church Street toward Woodstock/M176	160 m
3. Merge onto Lower Church St	500 m
4. Continue onto Church St	280 m
5. Turn left onto Victoria Rd	1,7 km
6. Continue onto Main Rd	400 m
7. Turn right onto Groote Schuur Dr	110 m
8. Take the 1st left toward Anzio Rd	270 m
9. Turn right onto Anzio Rd	210 m
10. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto the N2 ramp	170 m
11. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for N2/M3/Cape Town and merge onto N2	2,0 km
12. Take exit 4 for Roodebloem Road toward University Estate/Woodstock	110 m
13. Turn left onto Roodebloem Rd	600 m
14. Keep left at the fork	220 m
15. Merge onto De Waal Dr/N2 via the ramp to Capetown International Airport/Somerset W	1,0 km
16. Slight right onto De Waal Dr	240 m
17. Continue onto Rhodes Dr	2,6 km
18. Continue onto Union Ave	1,6 km
19. Continue onto Paradise Rd	550 m
20. Slight right to stay on Paradise Rd	90 m
21. Continue onto Edinburgh Dr	4,0 km
22. Continue onto Simon Van Der Stel Rd/M3	7,6 km
23. Turn left onto Steenberg Rd/M42 (signs for Steenberg Road/Muizenberg/Westlake)	850 m
24. Turn right onto Main Rd	500 m
25. Turn right onto Boyes Dr	6,8 km
26. Turn left onto Clairvaux Rd	250 m
27. Turn right onto Main Rd	2,6 km
28. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Simon's Town Rd	2,9 km
29. Continue onto Main Rd	3,4 km
30. Continue onto St Georges St/M4 Continue to follow M4	4,4 km
31. Turn right onto Rocklands Rd Destination will be on the right
