Cell life from Hebrews 10: 25

This is not the time to pull away and neglect meeting together ... we should come together even more frequently, eager to encourage and urge each other onward ...

May your first official gathering as a cell group be really meaningful. Your group is central to the mission of God's church. It's good to know that our mission can also be fun, especially when we see what God can do in all our lives. God bless you!!

1. Start your time together asking the group:

- What was the most significant thing God told you since you last met?
- What is the most significant thing God has shared with each person about their personal vision for 2022?
- How can we pray for that personal vision God has given you?
- What other needs can we pray for?

2. Pray for specific issues in the group:

- Celebrate the significant things God has told people
- Praise God for the visions and plans He has set in place for individuals
- Ask God to show everyone their personal vision for the year
- Ask God to meet the needs the group has shared

This week's scripture is short so there can be lots of meaningful discussion about fears and trusting God's Word etc.

(Background: Isaiah has just heard a blasphemous report from the King of Assyria, which is declaring that the Israelites should not listen to the one true God. It is when Isaiah hears this, after ripping his clothes in horror, that he makes this statement.)

2 Kings 19:6 - Thus says the Lord: Do not be afraid because of the words that you have heard, with which the servants of the king of Assyria have reviled me.

3. A possible strategy to encourage discoveries from the scripture

- a. Ask people to read the scripture in as many different Bible translations as possible.
- b. Spend time comparing the translations and what they emphasize.
- c. Allow a few people to recite the scripture.
- d. Ask people to share which part of the scripture stands out for them and why.
- e. Let people share how this scripture speaks to their present circumstances.
- f. Ask how they are going to allow this scripture to guide them through the next week.
- g. Pray for God's Spirit to strengthen the group to see the truth of this Word lived out in their lives.
