Draw a treasure box. Inside it, draw or write five blessings God has given you. Then ask yourself:

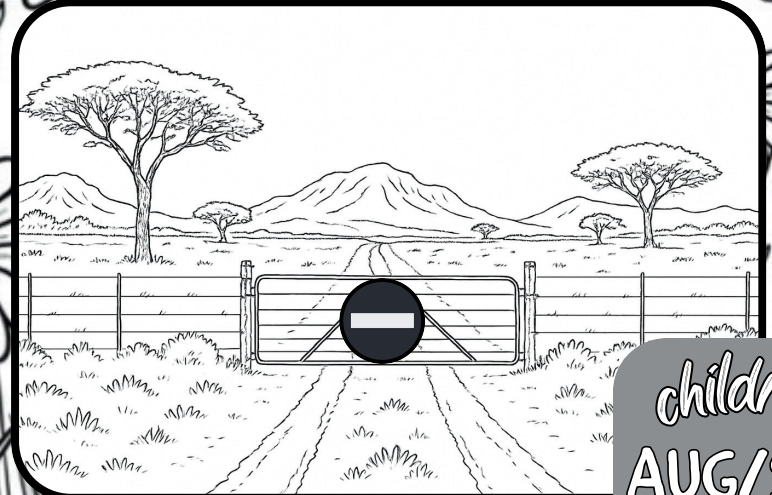
"Which one can I share with someone else this week?"

2. POST A PRAYER

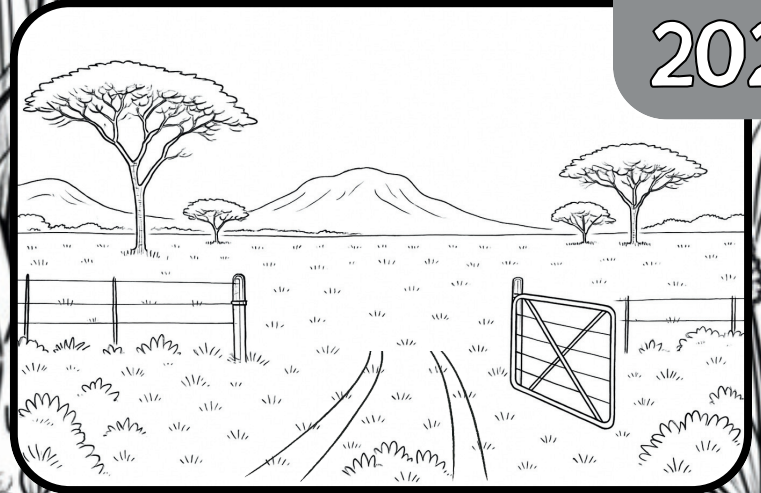
Write your prayer on your generation's coloured prayer card & post it to the Prayer Mountain in the ESCC foyer to show that you are praying for your generation.
